Sable Radio is an online independent radio station based in a former convent turned digital arts hub in, Leeds. We founded the station in 2019 with the aim of platforming the wide range of music, arts and culture happening in our city whilst also providing paid creative opportunities for young people. Since then we have broadcast over 400 + shows to over 100,000 people internationally.

Us and our studio



Alongside our radio programming we run workshops, host live music events, produce podcasts and have worked with Site Gallery, Leeds West Indian Carnival, Bound Art Book Fair, Compass Festival, Transform Festival Welcome Skate Store, Red Bull and more!

We are currently in an exciting, transitional phase; we are reshaping our visual identity, continuing to develop our production services and increasing our output as a station. We are looking for 4 young Black people in Leeds to work with us on our upcoming projects at the station whilst receiving experience and insight into radio production, podcasting, live streaming, event production and more.

What is ReSound?

ReSound is a 3 month mentorship and training programme. The programme is designed to be a full introduction to radio broadcasting, sound engineering and live event production.

We started the project to address the lack of paths into creative careers in Leeds, particularly for non-white people. We have also noticed an increased demand for people to have broad creative skill sets without opportunities to learn these skills or access expensive equipment, hopefully the project can help overcome these barriers to entry.

The programme consists of

- 15 days working with us at our studios
- 1to1 mentoring with industry professionals
- Workshops, talks and masterclasses
- A commissioned project

Working at Sable Radio

Each participant will be paid £100 per day, spending 15 days working with us at Sable Radio. Participants will learn about radio production, help us with broadcasting and work on upcoming projects. This will also be an opportunity for participants to work on specific areas that interest them, such as social media management, journalism & editorials, and photography.

1:1 mentoring

Throughout the programme, each participant will have 1:1 mentoring sessions with a selection of industry professionals. The sessions provide an opportunity for participants to ask questions, seek general advice and feedback on their commissioned project.

Workshops and Talks

A mix of masterclasses, workshops and panel discussions will be delivered by our partners, including Resident Advisor and Super Friendz. They will focus on specific industries and areas such as talent management, audio production and brand partnerships.

Commissioned Project

Each participant will receive £1000 to produce a project with us. We imagine this could be a live session, photoshoot or podcast series but we really want the project to be each participant's own idea.

Application Process

Stage 1

Alternatively - if neither method is appropriate for you, we want to make the process of applying right for you, so let us know if you have a preferred method

For example, you could arrange a phone call for you to talk through your answers and a member of the team can scribe.

Stage 2 - Interviews, week commencing 12th April 2021
Successful applicants will be invited for an interview. This will be more of an informal chat, for us to find out more about you as well as for you to ask us any questions about the programme. The interview will take roughly 30 minutes and take place on Zoom.

(a) The programme is for Black people, who are ages 18-25 and live in Leeds.

Q) When is the deadline?

(a) Monday April 5th 2021 @ 5pm

(a) We aim to respond to all application by Friday 9th April

Q) I am in full time education/employment, can I still apply ?

(a) Yes definitely! We only ask about employment status to get a better idea of what your committments and schedule might look like as this will inform how we schedule the programme
